

UEE31211 Certificate III in Instrumentation and Control.

This nationally recognized course is a natural progression for Electricians and final year Electrical Apprentices with suitable knowledge and skills in instrumentation and process automation.

This qualification provides competencies to undertake maintenance, installation, calibration, modifications and commissioning of systems and devices for measurement and recording of physical/chemical phenomenon and related process control.

All students participating in the program must be employed in instrumentation work and be able to learn the practical components through on-the-job training.

Competency based training and completion allows participants to move through their training efficiently while maintaining an emphasis on quality of work. Progression occurs as the participant attains competence rather than serving time.

Competency requires not just the possession of workplace related knowledge and skills but the demonstrated ability to apply specified knowledge and skills consistently over time in a sufficient range of work contexts.

Course costs

\$2800 for eligible participants

Training materials are included in the tuition fee, however there may be additional elective units that require students to purchase extra text books.

Students undertaking study in Victoria may be eligible for funding assistance.

Recognition of Current Competencies/RPL will be given to those core units of competency where participants hold a current electrical license or equivalent (Certificate III electrical qualification).

Assessment

Participants will be required to complete written and practical assessment tasks within and outside of classroom training time. Each Unit of Competency requires assessment activities which fully addresses all Elements and Performance Criteria. The activities are both theoretical and practical to confirm the participants required skills and underpinning knowledge.

Certification

This qualification is recognised within the Australian Qualifications Framework. A certificate will be awarded and a transcript of results will be issued upon successful completion of the course.

Any participant who withdraws or does not complete the course for any reason will be issued with a Statement of Attainment for the units which they have demonstrated competence
