

From 1st January 2015, all students doing nationally recognised training delivered by a registered training organisation (RTO) will need to have a Unique Student Identifier (USI).

Your USI is needed in order to obtain a certificate or qualification. It will give you online access to your training records and results (transcript) through your online USI account

Students who need a USI –

You will need a USI when you enrol or re-enrol in training from 1 January 2015 if you are a:

- student enrolling in nationally recognised training for the first time, for example if you are studying at TAFE or with a private training organisation, completing an apprenticeship or skill set, certificate or diploma course
- school student completing nationally recognised training; or
- student continuing with nationally recognised training.
- a student who is continuing study, is a student who has already started your course in a previous year (and not yet completed it) and will continue studying after 1 January 2015.
